



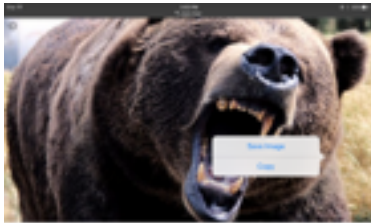
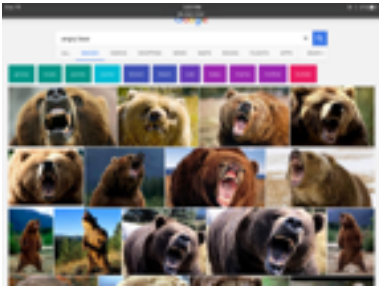
Green Screen by DoInk Tutorial

After you set up a green screen, record in the regular camera app.

2



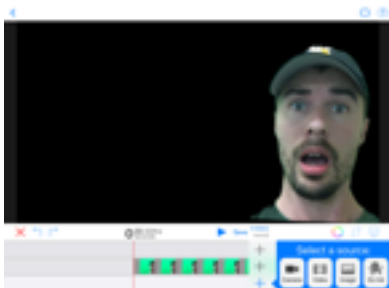
Search for the background you want and save to the camera roll.

3



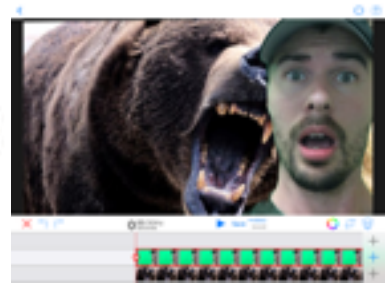
Open up Green Screen and create a new project.

4



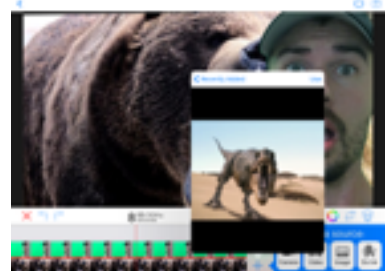
Insert the video in the middle row.

5



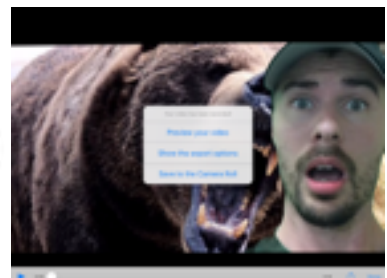
Add the background in the bottom row. You can resize both by pinching, zooming, and moving around the screen.

To add a second background, move the timeline to where you want it added, and then press to add another photo.

Press save to video and then export to camera roll.

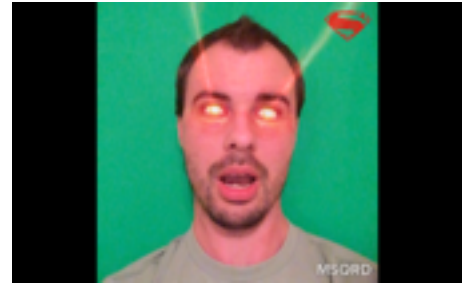

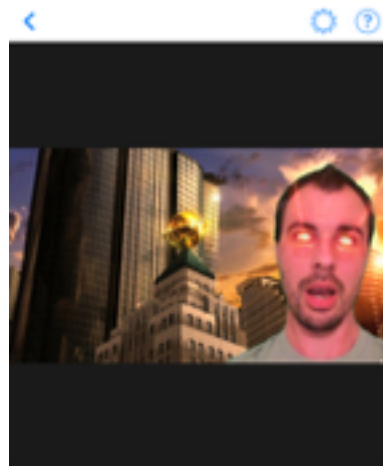
Search for an image and save to your camera roll.

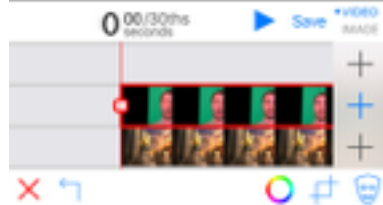
